What is HBD Príncipe?

HBD Príncipe ("HBD") is an ecotourism and agroforestry business based in the twin-island nation of São Tomé and Príncipe. With four unique boutique hotel properties (one of which is currently closed for refurbishment) as well as agricultural operations, our focus is on the sustainable development and conservation of Príncipe. What is the Conservation & Communities Contribution ("CCC")?

In alignment with <u>HBD Príncipe's vision</u>, guest rates for HBD hotels in Príncipe (Roça Sundy and Sundy Praia), include a CCC of €25 per person, per night (13+ years*). Through the CCC, guests at Roça Sundy and Sundy Praia directly support local projects. The amount received is distributed as follows:

COMPONENT 1

50% for the Príncipe Foundation: Our local NGO partner receives support for land and marine conservation projects on the island, effectuated in partnership with regional authorities and local communities.

COMPONENT 2

25% for Educational Support: Individuals, organizations, and schools in Príncipe receive support for a wide range of educational activities.

COMPONENT 3

25% for Environmental & Social Support: Individuals, organizations, and communities in Príncipe receive support for environmental and social initiatives and events.

*Between 1 October 2021 and 14 November 2022, the CCC was €10 per night for children 11 and under.



How did the CCC donation defray Fundação Príncipe's operating expenditure that cannot be recovered from specific project grants awarded to Fundação Príncipe by other donors?

Conservation project grants fund the significant majority of Fundação Príncipe's operating expenditure, including all activities directly affecting the biodiversity and communities of Príncipe Island. However, donors within the sector are typically unwilling to fund costs not directly contributing towards each project's conservation or development goals, often disregarding the underlying though necessary structural costs of the organizations that implement said projects. These include the core operating expenditures that potentiate the entirety of Fundação Príncipe's activity, thereby supporting the conservation of Príncipe's biodiversity and socioeconomic development. It is towards these unmet costs that the CCC donation contributed.

The expenses covered through the CCC donation consist of costs not directly linked to any one project. This is, nevertheless, crucial for the functioning of the organization as a whole and therefore indirectly contributed towards the whole of Fundação Príncipe's projects. Considering the abovementioned, the CCC supported:

Protetuga

The project aims to safeguard sea turtles in the waters and beaches of Príncipe by engaging local communities in conservation, raising awareness on the many threats facing these species, and promoting innovative approaches that reduce these threats. The project seeks to address illegal poaching, marine pollution, sand mining, and invasive predators through land- and sea-based monitoring of nesting activity, research partnerships with international institutions, and environmental education. Additionally, and as means of promoting more sustainable practices, the project supports alternative income initiatives that contribute towards a reduction in the marine pollution threatening marine turtles.

Omali Vida Nón

Aiming to mitigate threats to marine biodiversity and protect species and habitats around São Tomé and Príncipe, the project is facilitating the participatory designation and management of Marine Protected Areas by community members, local government, and other stakeholders. This approach has been developed through consultations with fishing communities on the two islands, supported by a suite of biological and socio-economic research.

The project is additionally engaging coastal communities to increase and diversify incomes through the provision of support and training for the development of sustainable micro-businesses, which directly contribute to the National Poverty Reduction Strategy, the National Sustainable Development Plan, and the objectives of the Príncipe Biosphere Reserve.

Stemming the Tide of Plastic Pollution on Príncipe Island

Through the establishment of partnerships with international researchers, the project aims to better understand the issue of marine plastic pollution on the island of Príncipe and design a strategy and regional framework to support turtle and marine conservation actions that can subsequently be replicated nationally and internationally. The project further intends to promote the local development of plastic waste-based income alternative initiatives that simultaneously contribute towards a reduction in pollution and the socioeconomic development of local communities, with a focus on women. This approach is aided by an ongoing awareness raising campaign on single-use plastic in local communities and schools.

In Situ Conservation of Threatened Trees

This project aims at increasing the *in situ* conservation efforts of three threatened tree species in São Tomé and Príncipe, namely *Carapa gogo, Strephonema sp.*, and *Chytranthus mannii*, by protecting their natural habitats, addressing species-specific threats, supporting natural regeneration, and boosting populations through planting if needed. This project aims also at raising threatened trees up the conservation agenda and catalyse other stakeholders to engage in their conservation.

Liqueza Téla Nón

The project intends to safeguard the globally relevant biodiversity and ecosystem services of Príncipe Island through the strengthening of capacity and national frameworks for biodiversity and natural resource management, integrated territorial planning, enforcement of the environmental legal framework, and improved management of protected areas.

The implementation of its various components is the responsibility of several government directorates, the Regional Government of Príncipe, and a consortium of NGOs led by BirdLife International, within which Fundação Príncipe is an implementing partner. Main project activities led by Fundação Príncipe include: updating the Príncipe Natural Park's (PNP) Management Plan; identifying High Conservation Value areas and formalizing innovative mechanisms that ensure their sustainable management; implementing biodiversity and threat monitoring protocols; building local capacity and providing technical support towards the effective management of the PNP; and engaging local stakeholders in the development and implementation of strategies for community led conservation management.

Plan for the Remaining Funds

Community Libraries

A total of $\leq 61,918.37$ has not yet been distributed. This is primarily due to two factors: i) there were fewer requests submitted and approved than expected (i.e., the funds contributed to the CCC during this period exceeded the cost of the approved requests); and ii) the plans for the CCC distribution were finalized and announced across Príncipe in 2022.

A vote among HBD team members concluded that the surplus funds should support community libraries. The importance of literacy—particularly early literacy—is well-researched and the community libraries project will be a worthy recipient of CCC funds.
